1450. Some typical and minor fine crazing to glaze. Two small flat chips to base corners of lantern, one tiny graze to glaze of right pixie boot. Pinhead sized glaze flake to back of hair. No restoration, in good condition overall. Some indistinct and minor scratches to green glaze of base.
