Condition Report

561. Ring mount � a central gem and two smaller gems are lacking. The mount is a little dented under the back of the front of the ring, ring size approx K. Mourning locket � the interior photographs to the locket have been removed in part. There is some chipping to the enamel work and also there is some perforation to the gold front of the locket. The frame and hinge of the locket are gilt base metal. Neckchain - the swivel clasp is rather worn.

Ring � weight 1.7g.
