A pair of Minton's Aesthetic porcelain plates, circa 1876, decorated in Japonisme style with a central fan, mon and bamboo against a pale celadon ground, impressed factory marks, diameter 24cm, together with a small group of other ceramics, including a Spode 'Full Cry' Hunting Scenes plate and a pair of chargers painted after Holbein.

Condition Report

1464. Minton's Aesthetic plates - both with surface wear, one with noticeable losses to the pale celadon ground. No chips, cracks or repairs. Both stained.

Spode plate with hunting scene - couple of surface scratches and minor losses to gilt.

Wedgwood boston plate - some crazing.

After Holbein chargers - overall crazing, minor surface wear.

Shaped square dish - some surface scratching.

Otherwise pieces in generally good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.
