A German Hanhart base metal circular cased military wristwatch, circa 1940s, the movement numbered '16662', the signed black dial with Arabic numerals, two subsidiary dials and red centre seconds, detailed to the screw steel case back 'Boden Edelstahl Wassergeschützt Stossfest 116632', with two setting buttons to the band, case diameter 4cm, on an associated black leather strap.

1020. The watch winds smoothly and adjusts and is currently working but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

The buttons to side click in as they should but do not work the centre seconds at all (no response).

Overall watch is generally in good condition with typical surface scratches and wear to case and glass. Dial is ok with some typical degrading to luminous hours and hands.
