A Royal Worcester porcelain shell centrepiece, circa 1879, modelled as an ivory glazed nautilus shell surmounted by a gilt bronzed lizard, raised on a coral stem and circular base relief detailed with shells and weed picked out in bronzed and gilded detail, impressed, incised and puce printed marks to base, height 22cm.
