Condition Report

2527. The box has a few minor repairs, including a small replaced section to one side and a replaced escutcheon.

Decanter 1: small chip to one bottom corner, small nicks to shoulders. Stopper which is later, is stuck in neck. Decanter 2: internal crack in shoulders and small nicks to edges. Later stopper is stuck in neck.

Decanter 3. Very think star crack to one side, some small nicks and edges and slight tear to collar. Later stopper.

Decanter 4. Some small nicks to edges.

Corkscrew is in generally good order.
