## LOT 1475

A Doulton Lambeth Gothic style stoneware oil lamp, late 19th century, probably decorated by Edith Lupton, the pail shaped top with stylized upright fleur-de-lys gilt metal rim, decorated with stylized foliage, raised on a twisted gilt metal stem and similarly decorated gilt metal mounted domed foot, with glass reservoir and Hinks's Duplex Patent fittings, overall height 45cm (repaired).

Estimate: £150 - £250

## Condition Report

1475. Stoneware reservoir support on twisted stem with long vertical crack running from rim to underside edge. Centre of twisted stem with large blemish. Upper neck of domed stoneware foot broken in 2 and visibly glued with associated vertical crack running length of foot. Faults to lamp mechanism which shows signs of electric conversion.
