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An Omega Seamaster steel circular cased gentleman's wristwatch, circa 1960, the signed jewelled movement numbered '17467404', the signed black dial with gilt Arabic numerals and arrow shaped hour markers, the case back detailed 'Seamaster', case diameter 3.3cm, on a black strap, together with a Seiko Automatic Navigator Timer steel cased gentleman's bracelet wristwatch, the signed dial with baton hour markers, centre seconds and date aperture, the steel bracelet with a Seiko fold-over clasp, case width 3.7cm, and a Buler Bulldog steel backed gentleman's wristwatch, the signed black dial with baton shaped hour markers and day and date apertures, on a steel bracelet, case width 3.8cm.
