A pair of English cameo glass silver mounted salts, circa 1890, probably Webb, the red oval bodies overlaid in white and carved with flowers and foliage beneath the silver mounted rims, Birmingham 1890 by Horton & Allday, length of each 4.3cm.

Condition Report

1623. One - slight rubbing to hallmark. A few noticeable nibbles to the border directly below the silver rim. A couple of tiny pin sized nick to footrim. Otherwise in good condition.

Two - rubbing to hallmark. A few larger noticeable nibbles/chips to the border directly below the silver rim. Otherwise in good condition.
