An English Delft charger, probably Bristol, circa 1760, painted in blue with chinoiserie style pierced rockwork sprouting bamboo, peony and chrysanthemum, the rim with floral groups beneath a geometric band, the rim underside with three squiggles, unmarked, diameter 33cm (minor restoration).

Estimate: £70 - £100

## **Condition Report**

1402. Small areas of restoration to upper rim edge at 3 and 9 o'clock, both encroaching ever so slightly onto underside rim edge. Two chips to footrim 2.5 and 1.5cm long. Otherwise typical fritting/small chips to rim circumference.
