A Worcester Japan Fan pattern tea bowl and saucer and matching teacup and saucer, circa 1770, pseudo Chinese disguised numeral marks to bases, diameter of saucers 12cm and 13cm, together with a pair of Royal Worcester Fan pattern dinner plates, circa 1884, puce printed factory marks to bases, diameter 26.4cm.

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

1413. Teabowl - in good condition overall, no cracks, chips or restoration, scratch to side interior (not through decoration) and teeny tiny flake to gilt rim only noticeable on very close inspection.

Teacup - some loss and wear to gilt rim, minor surface scratches to exterior, light wear to base interior, some manufacturers fritting to footrim.

Small saucer - small patch of surface scratches (not through decoration) to edge of central blue band and minor scratch to central iron red circle of medallion.

Large saucer - some minor manufacturers fritting to footrim, otherwise OK.

Dinner Plates - both with typical light surface wear/knife cuts and minor rubbing to gilt rims, otherwise OK.
