### LOT 1433

A Sèvres porcelain circular dish, circa 1766, painted by Tardy, monogrammed, with floral bouquets against the low relief petal moulded body, the rim with cobalt blue line and gilt dash detail, blue painted marks to base, diameter 21.2cm, together with four similar dinner plates and a similarly painted coffee can and two saucers, various blue painted, impressed and incised marks to bases (some faults).

Estimate: £70 - £100

### Condition Report

1433. Circular Bowl - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Very, very minor rubbing to gilt rim.

Four plates - first heavily worn and scratched to well, otherwise OK. Second with some stacking wear and knife cuts to well, otherwise OK. Third with some stacking wear and knife cuts to well, otherwise OK. Fourth with some light staking wear and knife cuts to well, otherwise OK.

Two Saucers - one with 4cm long haircrack to rim and very light surface scratches, other with very light surface scratches and small spot of wear to gilt rim.

Cup - heavily crazed, small chip to footrim and approx 1cm long vertical haircrack to rim.
