Condition Report

19. Relined, previously cleaned and restored. Restoration includes filling and overpainting to a few small holes to the background to the left of the sitter. Further overpainting to a small area of paint loss in the same area and elsewhere, particularly around the feigned oval where presumably a previous frame or mount has rubbed the surface. Other touches of overpainting. Craquelure throughout. Paint a little thin in areas from previous cleans. Frame with chips and cracks around the extremities.
