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An early 20th century Neoclassical Revival satinwood three-section wardrobe with moulded gilt swag decoration, the doors with radiating sunburst crossbanding, enclosing drawers and slides, raised on carved flower cusp feet, height 194cm, width 202cm, depth 58cm.

Estimate: £100 - £200

Condition Report

2006. The overall condition and appearance is very good with no clear signs of restoration or repair. There is one small chip to the carved terminal on the pediment, also a similar chip to top edge of the carving of one foot. There is a small area of damage to the veneer around the left side handle, and similar but more minor damage around the other handle. The central swag moulding is slightly loose on its right side. Otherwise, some very light wear to the gilt in places and a few minor bumps and marks. No apparent warping to doors, no cracks or splits.

Interior depth for hanging 51cm.
