Condition Report

2186. The original top half section is in reasonable condition but has a small piece of moulded trim missing to right side of top. There is a slight crack across the bird's eye maple top and some overall minor faults to the veneer. The interior is missing two extra doors that should fit in front of the drawers. Otherwise, the stand is made up from snooker table legs.
