A First Pattern Fairbairn Sykes fighting knife with straight double-edged blade, blade length 16.5cm, detailed 'The F-S Fighting Knife, Wilkinson Sword, London', S-shaped guard and chequered grip, with later stitched leather sheath.

1802. The sheath is clearly not the original and is just a crudely stitched hand-made replacement. Some minor knocks and surface wear to handle, surface wear to blade and some slight black discolouration to tip.
