Condition Report

210. The larger section at the bottom of the drop is cracked through and appears to have been partly crushed, one larger pearl missing from this section. The smaller pendant drop does not sit comfortably and has perhaps been repositioned. The piece has been re-threaded in places but is now starting to work loose. Top section is in generally good condition, pearl to bottom of bud at centre of top looks to be a smaller replacement � the original might have been rather larger. Otherwise considering the age and nature of the item it is in fairly good condition. Case in good condition.
