A French platinum, diamond, sapphire and blue gem set brooch, circa 1920, of tapered elliptical form, collet set with the principal cushion shaped diamond to the centre, otherwise set with smaller cushion shaped diamonds and calibre cut sapphires and blue gems, width 8.8cm, with case detailed Hunt & Roskell Ltd.

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### Condition Report

331. The principal diamond slightly draws colour but looks to be a clear stone. The remaining diamonds are generally mixed old cut stones. Note variation of cut of the baguette blue gemstones. Otherwise in good condition. Dates to 1920s/30s. Weight 8.1g.

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
