Condition Report

517. Good clean condition, no significant damage or repairs. Nice bright white sparkly stones. Length of head of stick pin is 1.9cm.

Case in generally good order with some typical wear to the plush covering. The fabric hinge is in good order but the metal hinge is loose from the bottom section of the case, so would require some attention. It is difficult to be absolutely certain whether the case is original but there is no real reason to doubt it and we would suggest it probably is. It is a Garrard & Co case and detailed 'To the crown...'. Gilt lettering is worn.
