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A Victorian 15ct gold, diamond and red gem set ring, designed as two entwined snakes, mounted with a cushion shape diamond, two rose cut diamonds and two red gems, Birmingham 1889, ring size approx N (one further gem lacking).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

589. The principal cushion shaped diamond has numerous internal inclusions. The principal red gem is probably garnet but it is very badly chipped. The rose diamond eyes have one or two internal inclusions. The cabochon red gem set eye is a bit worn and the other red gem set eye is lacking. The shank of the ring has been sized in the past. There is slight internal scratching to the band. Weight 5.2g.

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
