A cut glass engraved club shaped decanter and stopper, mid-19th century, engraved with a crowned 'N' for Napoleon III above a wide border of strawberry diamonds beneath the faceted neck, the flattened disc stopper with scalloped edge and a band of strawberry diamonds, height 29cm, together with three Victorian glass spirit measures.

Estimate: £50 - £100

Condition Report

1637. Decanter - minute nick to base end of stopper and little nicks to faceted edges of stopper. Decanter itself not clouded. Pinhead sized dig/blemish to side of engraved 'N' and similar almost juxtapose, with another indistinct amidst strawberry diamonds - all quite insignificant. Mid-19th century.

Spirit Measures - Victorian. Largest: detailed 'Richardson's Patent' and engraved 'W. McDowall'. In good condition, minor blemishes to facet edges. Middle size: cloudy. Detailed 'Richardson's Patent'. Generally in good condition. Small chips around pewter seal button and minor blemishes to facet edges. Smallest: good condition.
