A mid-20th century Elgin National Watch Co Royal Navy chrome plated keystone base metal cased keyless wind open-faced deck watch, the signed gilt jewelled movement detailed 'R.W. Raymond' and numbered '41753388', the signed dial with MoD arrow, Arabic hours and outer minutes, the signed screw case back interior numbered '83327', the signed case back detailed 'H.S.3' (Hydrographic Service) with MoD arrow and numbered '53388', case diameter 5cm (lacking glass), within a hinged folding fitted glazed mahogany deck case.
