### LOT 1010

A pair of Chinese doucai porcelain circular saucer dishes, mark of Chenghua but Qing dynasty, each centre painted with a stylized pomegranate tree with leaves and fruiting branches within a rim of further pomegranates, fruiting vine and blossoming branch, underglaze blue six-character mark within double-ring to base, diameter 14.3cm (one repaired).

### Condition Report

1010. Saucer dish 1 - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical minor surface wear and scratches to enamels and glaze on rim. Small bruise to footrim, but no significant damage or repairs.

Saucer dish 2 - broken into 6 pieces and re-glued, but not to anywhere near professional standard. Some minor chips/losses to edges of breaks. Small chip to footrim. Restoration required. Otherwise typical minor surface scratches and wear.
