### LOT 1040

A Chinese blue and white porcelain vase and cover, mark of Kangxi but late 19th century, painted with two maidens and a boy in a garden setting, underglaze blue six-character mark within a double-ring to base, height 30cm (faults), together with a small group of other Oriental porcelain, including a Chinese blue and white vase with iron oxide borders, a famille verte ginger jar and cover with iron oxide borders and a Japanese plate (faults).

Estimate: £50 - £80

### Condition Report

1040. Vase & cover - impact to neck rim with unsprung chipping and two associated long haircracks going to shoulders of vase. Small fritted chip to neck rim too. Six large chips to edge of cover and chip to tail of Buddhistic lion finial.

Blue & white vase with oxide borders - glued repair to foot and neck rim, also with a chip and minor losses to neck rim.

Famille verte ginger jar - good condition, lacking cover.

Crackle glazed ginger jar and cover - good condition.

Buddha - good condition.

Plate - manufacturers firing crack to rim, otherwise in good condition.
