LOT 1231

A Chinese blue and white Kraak porcelain circular dish, late Ming dynasty, probably Wanli period, the centre painted with an octagonal medallion filled with two birds, peonies and rocks, framed by a segmented rim of flowers and precious objects, diameter 29.5cm (repair to rim), applied 'Guest & Gray' paper label to base.

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

1231. A section of rim (approx 15cm long x 5.5cm deep) has been broken away in two pieces and restored with museum type visible restoration, another section (approx 22cm x 5.5cm) has been broken away in four pieces and similarly restored. Both of these areas have minor hairlines radiating from them. A manufacturing blemish to the footrim has a later minor chip. Typical fritted chipping to the rim circumference and some typical light surface scratches.
