A pair of Doulton faience pottery vases, dated 1898, the ovoid bodies decorated by Mary M. Arding, monogrammed, with white clematis against a pale lemon ground, turquoise glazed interiors, impressed and painted marks to bases, height 23cm.

Estimate: £50 - £80

Condition Report

Both in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. One of the vases has some insignificant glaze fritting to the top rim edge - more easily felt than seen. Both vases have fine crazing to the glaze and some very minor flaking to the raised enamel detail, e.g. a small spot on each main flower, this is quite insignificant (and typical) and only really noticeable on closer inspection.
