An unusual studio pottery jug, dated 1950, in the style of Rye, the ovoid body covered in a white slip and painted with an oval view of the River Thames, titled 'The Pool of London', within stylized foliate framing, the neck with a wavy geometric design, incised 'IR' to base, height 34cm (fault to lower handle terminal).

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

An approx 3 by 2cm section of the handle at the lower terminal has been broken away in one large piece and visibly glued. A small slither along the break line is also loose and is included with the lot. Otherwise the jug is in good condition with no cracks or restoration. There are some very minor and light surface scratches to the widest part of the body.
