A Meissen porcelain figure emblematic of Spring, mid-18th century, modelled as a maiden wearing a floral decorated yellow cloak, holding an urn of flowers, a cat at her feet, raised on a scroll moulded base applied with flowers, underglaze blue factory mark to reverse edge of base, height 14cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £100 - £200

Condition Report

1415. Fundamentally in good condition overall with no restoration.

Minute nick to side edge of footrim by cat. Tiny nick underneath toes of right foot. Minor nibbled chipping to billowing edge of cloak. Missing right little finger and a couple of stems of flowers from urn.
