LOT 550

A 15ct gold, peridot and seed pearl pendant, circa 1910, in a scroll pierced and foliate design, collet set with an oval cut peridot to the centre and a circular cut peridot to the drop, otherwise set with seed pearls, length 5.4cm, with a gold circular link neckchain on a boltring clasp, detailed '15ct', length 42cm, with a later case.

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

550. Appears to be in good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear visible under magnification. The pendant is in overall good condition. The chain is in good condition, but would benefit from a clean.

The peridots are of medium colour saturation with one or two tiny nicks to the table facet edges, but nothing significant. The seed pearls are generally of an attractive fresh colour.

Pendant - weight 5.1g

Chain - weight 2.4g.

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
