Three La Courtille (Paris) porcelain baluster shaped custard cups and covers, circa 1790, polychrome painted with floral sprays and scattered flowers within gilt dentil borders, the covers with acorn knops, blue crossed torches marks to bases, height 7.5cm (one with repaired handle and restored cover).

Estimate: £180 - £220

Condition Report

1425. Cups - one cup with handle broken in three pieces and (just about) visibly glued with no losses, gilding to foot rubbed/worn. One cup with small area of professional restoration to rim above main flower decoration. Third cup in good order.

Covers - first in good condition with no chips, cracks or restoration. Second extensively but professionally restored overall. Third with two areas of professional restoration to rim edge.
