A mid to late 19th century Austrian walnut cased Vienna wall clock with eight day Lenzkirch movement striking hours and half hours on a gong, the two piece enamel dial with Roman numerals, the architectural case with arched surmount and glazed door and sides above a tapered apron, height 124cm, with pendulum, two weights and winding key.

Condition Report

1178. A good quality Vienna regulator in overall good condition. Case with very little damage apart from a few typical scuffs and nicks. No case parts missing. Slight warping to front door. Mechanism with deadbeat escapement with adjustable pallets. All parts there, but minor problem with the strike train. In need of a clean and minor adjustments to bring it back to full working order. Original weights and winding key.
