A late Victorian Arts and Crafts ebonized ash Sussex armchair by Morris & Co, designed by Philip Webb, the turned spindle back above a rush seat, on turned legs united by stretchers, height 85cm, width 54.5cm, depth 43cm.

## **Condition Report**

4022. General condition and appearance is ok, with overall typical but fairly minor surface wear to ebonizing. Both arm joints are slightly wobbly and the joints overall are a little loose. One leg has a light scattering of old woodworm holes. The tip of one of the arm supports underneath the seat has a re-spliced repair and there are some very minor surface splits to some of the turnings.
