A pair of early 19th century figured mahogany chests, each fitted with four drawers flanked by rounded pilasters, on bun feet, height 103cm, width 116cm, depth 60cm.

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

2184. One chest is more faded than the other.

Chest 1 - the more faded chest has a small section of veneer loss to rear edge. Small section of veneer missing to rear edge left side, edge of rounded base section of both pilasters, and a few other small chips to veneer. All handles are original, but the two top ones have been pushed in and misshapen.

Chest 2 - the darker chest has some chips to the veneer around the front sections of the drawers, also around the rounded base section of the right-hand pilaster. There is a chip to the block at the top of the same pilaster, also some scratches to middle drawer.

Overall minor scuffs and scratches to both chest. The friezes are fitted with concealed drawers.
