Condition Report

1089. Generally in good condition with vibrant colours, some typical light wear and scratches to gilt ground and some minor wear and loss to painted tree, leaves and flowers, minor damp staining to bottom left corner. The hinges are generally good but some minor losses and paper lifting to the inner edges of the hinged sections. Some drill holes to back where previously mounted on a single baton.
