A Chinese coral coloured silk embroidered jacket/short robe, late Qing dynasty, finely worked in coloured threads with a design of scattered flowers, fruit and butterflies on a coral ground, the borders and collar decorated with flowers and foliage on a cream ground, with gilt metal fastenings, length 109cm (faults).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1234. There are considerable condition issues with this robe, the collar is badly worn with losses and tears, the coral ground has areas of fading and staining as well as badly frayed and worn sections particularly around the neck, shoulders and lower side vents. The two back panels have become largely unstitched down the central seam, the borders are also worn and some of the yellow edging has come away with some losses. The blue lining has similar wear and discolouration/staining. The embroidery colours remain vibrant. Please see extra images on our website.
