A Chinese famille rose export armorial porcelain meat dish, Qianlong period, enamelled and gilt with the Arms of Gregory, within a flower festoon border, length 41.5cm (minor chip to rim). Note: a similarly decorated armorial octagonal dish is illustrated on page 621 of 'Chinese Armorial Porcelain' by David Sanctuary Howard.

1181. Small chip approx 0.5cm square to bottom rim of dish, otherwise in good condition with no cracks, or restoration. Gilding is bright, colours are vibrant. Typical light surface wear and scratches.
