An early Victorian needlework sampler by Hannah Matkin, Aged 13, dated 1838, worked in coloured threads with a central verse surrounded by a small cottage, two opposing hippocampi, plants and trees, 49cm x 51cm, within a period mahogany frame.

Condition Report

2801. Overall slight browning and typical slight fading of colours. There is a tear to the left side of the upper central tree, a very small hole to lower left corner and a few other very tiny holes elsewhere.

The frame, as can be seen in the photographs, has numerous pieces missing from the sectional mahogany and ebony veneers.
