A Rolex Oyster Perpetual Submariner stainless steel cased gentleman's wristwatch, circa 1964, model number 5513, the signed glossy black dial with gilt detailed '200m=660Ft Submariner' above 'Swiss - T<25', with luminous dot and baton hour markers, Mercedes hour hand, centre seconds and outer rotating bezel, Rolex crown to winding button, numbered between the lugs '5513' and '1084735', case diameter 4cm, on a black leather strap.

Condition Report

1035. The watch is in generally very good condition commensurate with age. Winds and adjusts smoothly and is currently in good working order, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. The winding button with Rolex crown motif screws in nice and tightly. The dial appears in generally good condition with a good gloss finish and distinct bold gilt detail and lettering. Under magnification you can see some minor craquelure to the black surface with a few minor spots and some minor wear/scratching through 'Swiss' under 6 o'clock. However this is only really noticeable under magnification, to the naked eye it appears a good clean glossy dial. The glass/crystal has typical surface scratches, but again only really noticeable under magnification. The case and bezel are also in good condition with typical surface scratches and wear that you would expect to see on a watch of this type. Leather strap is worn.
