A late George III mahogany roll-top writing desk, the top with gilt metal gallery above a tambour fall front enclosing a pull-out writing surface, the frieze fitted with two drawers, on square tapering legs with gilt metal caps, height 105cm, width 93cm, depth 67cm (some faults).

## **Condition Report**

2070. The exterior of the desk is generally in good order with only minor scuffs and marks. There are two small patches of restored veneer on left corner of frieze. The drawer handles have been replaced a few times. The interior drawer/pigeonhole section has dropped in the middle resulting in that section being quite crooked. The writing slope is slightly warped and one hinge is detached. One of the handles on the pull-out slide is detached.
