A Victorian gold backed and silver set diamond brooch, designed as two interlinked crescents and a trefoil terminal to each end of the each bar, mounted with cushion cut diamonds, width 3.5cm.

Estimate: £350 - £400

Condition Report

512. The condition is generally quite good with no significant damage or repairs. Typical surface scratches and wear. The principal diamond slightly draws colour and has a few internal inclusions. The remaining diamonds also have one or two internal inclusions. The brooch hook at the back is replaced. The brooch is rather heavily tarnished and would benefit from professional cleaning. Pin is slightly bent. Weight 5.5g.

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
