A mid-18th century silver and foil backed flat cut garnet brooch, designed as a spray, mounted with variously cut flat cut garnets, length 6cm (subsequent adaptations and damage).

Condition Report

515. Three possibly four garnets are missing. One garnet near to where two of the garnets are missing is badly cracked. Other garnets in generally good condition. There is slight variation of colour. Old lead solder repairs are visible at the back. Pin hinge and hook are probably later adaptations. The piece may have been part of something larger in the past. Weight 13.2g.
