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A George II needlework sampler by Charlotte Martin, dated 1758, finely worked in coloured silks with lines of verse within bands of flowering vines, $35 \, \text{cm} \times 29 \, \text{cm}$, within a bird's eye maple frame.

Condition Report

2806. Generally good colours with no clear stains or browning. There are a few spots of damage - right hand side border about halfway down, a few very small holes and also some slight loss of thread to some of the border flowerheads. The frame has a small nick off the veneer to one corner.

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
