A Chinese famille rose export porcelain spoon tray, Qianlong period, of lobed oval form, painted with rockwork issuing peonies, length 12.8cm (firing crack to rim), together with a Chinese blue and white export porcelain saucer, Kangxi period, painted with a boy amidst flowers and tendrils, diameter 11.5cm (cracked).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

1004. Spoon Tray - 2cm firing crack to rim, otherwise no significant damage or restoration. Some wear to surface enamels and glaze.

Saucer - a starcrack to centre of base and some minor chips/fritting to rim. Otherwise generally in good condition.
