A Sino-Tibetan gilt bronze figure of Amitayus, mark of Qianlong but probably 19th century, modelled seated in dhyanasana on a rectangular openwork plinth draped in a cloth, incised nine-character mark to front of plinth, height 17cm (missing mandala to back of figure).

## Condition Report

1200. Please note the figure is missing its flame mandala. Otherwise the figure is in generally good condition, with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear, the wear to gilt more pronounced to high points. Some minor discolouration in places.
