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A late Victorian gold backed and silver set diamond brooch, circa 1900, designed as a curved floral spray, mounted with cushion and rose cut diamonds, width 6.5cm.

Estimate: £350 - £450

Condition Report

684. The diamonds are attractive white stones and look to be fairly clear. One or two have tiny inclusions. The brooch is generally in good condition. There would have been at one stage a screw-in fitting positioned at the back of the flowerhead, this is now missing. The flowerhead is probably in association with the spray. A well achieved alteration from the original form. Weight 12.4g. The principal diamond is approx 0.20ct and then smaller stones to the rest of the setting.

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
