## **LOT 2532**

A selection of eighteen mostly Victorian silver bladed and mother-ofpearl folding fruit knives, including a George III example, Sheffield 1818, extended length 13.5cm.

## **Condition Report**

2532. The majority have a degree of typical minor surface wear to both the grips and blades. Four of the fairly ordinary knives have slightly bent and worn blades. Three other fairly plain examples have small cracks and one loose grip to the mother-of-pearl as well as lightly bent and worn blades. The largest foliate engraved knife has a section of mother-of-pearl missing on grip, a stud missing and the blade does not retract as it should.
