A George I walnut and elm chest-on-stand, the eight crossbanded drawers with original brass handles and boxwood stringing, the stand raised on later turned feet, height 137cm, width 101cm, depth 53cm (alterations).

## Condition Report

2137. The top half of the chest is all reasonably original and generally in fairly good order. It has some re-veneered repairs to the crossbanded on the right side and some repairs to the moulded pediment. The back panel has been replaced with a piece of ply and the top panel, which is a nice piece of elm, looks like a later addition.

The base has been reduced in height, having probably lost its original legs and stretchers. There are additional later pieces of pine serving to support the later feet and the mouldings around the edges are also later.
