A Cartier Tank Cintr Americaine large white gold cased gentleman's wristwatch, circa 1930s, the jewelled movement detailed 'European Watch and Clock Co Inc, 19 Jewels 8 Adj. Swiss', with dust cover, the signed silvered rectangular dial with black Roman numerals, the curved rectangular case with sapphire cabochon set crown, the lugs detailed '2820' and '22688', case length 4.7cm, case width 2.55cm, on a red leather strap.

The watch appears to be in generally good clean condition. The case is in generally good clean condition with only typical minor scratches and wear.

The dial has had some restoration and re-painting visible under magnification and some slightly more obvious repainting around the screw holes above the 12 o'clock and under the 6 o'clock positions.

The watch winds smoothly and is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.
