An early 20th century French marble and brass four glass mantel clock garniture, the clock with eight day movement striking on a gong, the case with bevelled glass panels, the variegated marble top and base with serpentine sides, on toupie feet, height 31cm, with mercury compensated pendulum and key, flanked by a pair of matching urns, height 28.5cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

1154. The clock does not run or wind, otherwise cosmetically the garniture is in generally good condition commensurate with age. Typical light surface wear, scuffs and scratches, and a bit dirty and dusty. One urn has a chip to its rim, otherwise no significant damage or repairs.
