1210. The clock is in generally good condition commensurate with age. No signs of woodworm and no significant damage or repairs. Typical minor faults such as chips to veneer, scuffs, minor splits etc. Everything is in place for it to work with pendulum, weights and winding key all present, but we do not test the longcase clocks, they are sold as seen and we do not give any guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock. Usually a longcase clock and many other clocks need to have a service and be set up correctly to run as they should. Height 237cm, width of hood 62cm, width of base 58cm, depth 25cm.
